- Support the district programme team in developing international awareness
- Support section leaders to deliver international programme to their sections
- Promote join in activities for large UK international events such as Join in Jamboree
- Maintain a record of all members going abroad as a part of their scouting
- Maintain and update information on international opportunities available to both young people and adults
- Provide a point of contact for County International Team
- Provide advice to Groups and sections on the visits abroad process
- Attend county international meetings

- Own and manage the District International Fund
